

Welcome to the 79th Annual Wisconsin State Dartball Tournament

This year's tournament will host 112 teams at the beautiful Eau Claire Indoor Sports Center, 3456 Craig Road in Eau Claire. This is 23 more teams than were here last time in 2012.

There will be shirts for sale at \$15 dollars each and darts for \$35 a dozen. There will also be basswood boards available to order through Travis Logslett. We will have one board there for display and the cost is \$200. If you'd like to order one, there will be contact info for you to take.

A variety of beer will be sold. By order of the City of Eau Claire, anyone 21 or older who wishes to drink must have a wristband. NO BEER IS ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF THE SPORTS CENTER OR IN THE PARKING LOT. Please, please follow these rules as we would like to continue to host this event at this location and have a good relationship with the City of Eau Claire. It is a privilege for the city to allow us to sell alcohol. Thank you for your help in this matter.

The shootoff will be the same as last year. We will again have an above 500 and below 500 division. Top three in each division will receive trophies. There will be 8 shootoff boards available near the beer garden. New this year will be a 50/50 Poker Shooting competition. For \$1 you get 10 darts to throw at a board with two decks of cards on it. Your goal is to get the best poker hand. You must hit 5 cards to have a qualifying hand. After 50 people have gone, the best hand will get \$25 and then the game will reset with the next 50. There will only be two boards available.
